<sup>1</sup> A Performance Group (approved for music majors) must be passed every semester. Guitar majors may use guitar ensemble for four semesters to count toward major ensemble credit. Jazz Combo, Jazz Ensemble, Ladies & Gentlemen of Jazz and Opera Theatre students can receive up to two credits for participation in these groups out of the eight semesters of performance group credits required. Note: MUFC students must pass MUS 101 and 103 before progressing into music technology classes beyond MUS 105.

<sup>2</sup> Additional Film Scoring courses are suggested for general electives. These could include Music Distribution & Social Media (MUS 316), Sound Stage Scoring (MUS 318), Sound Stage Recording (MUS 381), Music Industry Practices (MUS 389), Principles of Audio Production (TVF 128), Fundamentals of Scriptwriting (TVF 318), or Producing and Directing (TVF 447)
