Jazz Combo, Jazz Ensemble, Ladies & Gentlemen of Jazz and Opera Theatre students can receive up to two credits for participation in these groups out of the eight semesters of performance group credits required.
 Note: MUFC students must pass MUS 101 and 103 before progressing into music technology classes beyond MUS 105.
